

Strengthening Families Program 6-11

FY 2017-2018 Summary Snapshot

North Carolina Strengthening Families Program Network Statewide Summary

Overview

For the period of July 2017 through June 2018, 16 SFP 6-11 cycles were conducted at six NC SFP agencies with a total enrollment of 181 parents/caregivers and 228 children ages 6 to 11, representing 140 families. Using a repeated measures retrospective pre- and post-test design, 123 data sets were submitted for analysis. The scorable sample size for individual subscales ranged from 90 to 120.

Findings

Analyses of individual subscales show statistically significant improvements for each of the 14 outcomes (p-value of 0.05 or less indicating mathematical confidence that the result is reliable and unlikely to have been produced by chance). Outcomes for cluster scales looking at results across family, parenting, and child outcomes are listed below. Outcomes for each individual family, parent, and child subscales are shown in the charts to the right. Effect sizes (Cohen's *d*) are noted for all scales indicating the magnitude of change.

*SMALL: Cohen's *d* = less than 0.20

**MODERATE: Cohen's *d* = 0.20 - 0.50

***LARGE: Cohen's *d* = greater than 0.50

Family Outcomes***

The Family Cluster Scale showed large change across all outcomes. (*d*=0.74)

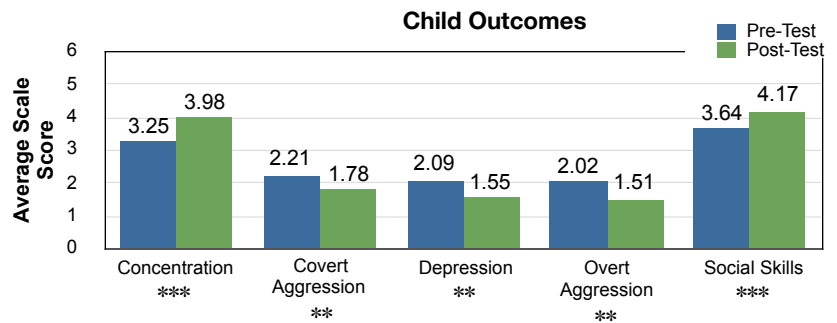
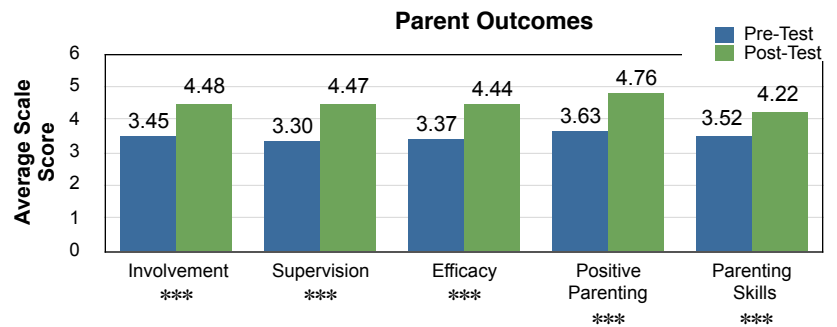
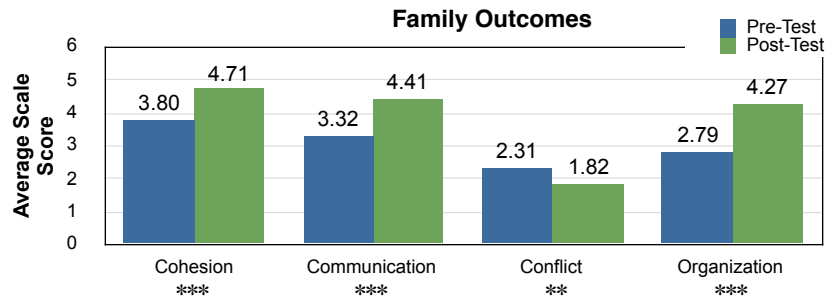
Parent Outcomes***

Child Outcomes***

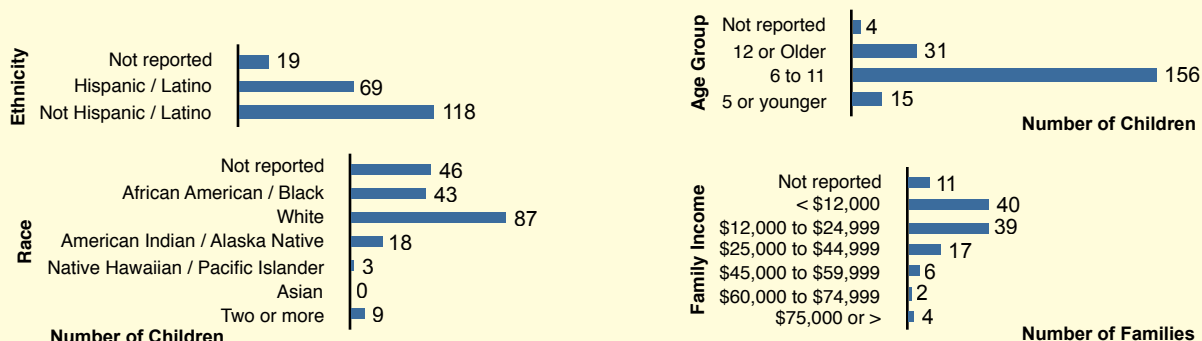
The Child Cluster Scale showed large change across all outcomes. (*d*=0.58)
